

THALIA MURRAY SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION for 2011

We appreciate your applying for this \$2,000 Scholarship offered by Bruce and Kevin Murray via EdUCate!, the non-profit University City Foundation for Public Schools. EdUCate! sponsors many events to benefit Public Education for the 5 schools in the University City area such as "Taste of the Triangle," "Honor a Teacher," "Oktoberfest," "Teacher Wish List," and "Dollar a Day."

This scholarship is offered in memory of our mother, Thalia Murray, who taught for the SD Unified School District for 20 years, including 17 years at Marcy Elementary (now Mission Bay Montessori) in UC. Our mother received an anonymous scholarship that allowed her to start attending a high-quality, 4-year college from which she graduated. That scholarship dramatically increased her options. By closely working with a committee comprised of key EdUCate! Board members, our goal is for this Scholarship to help its recipient.

This Scholarship has been awarded since 2005 to one (1) eligible Senior at University City High School in the total amount of \$2,000.00. In the event that we find two outstanding candidates, we reserve the right to split the \$2,000.00 Scholarship into two equal \$1,000.00 Scholarships or else to increase the Scholarship amount.

ELIGIBILITY:

This Scholarship is open to all academically qualified students who have:

1. Attained Senior standing and who will graduate from University City High School in June 2011 with an overall cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Please include your official 4-year transcript with this application.
2. Cumulative Citizenship of 3.0 or higher, as shown by the same official 4-year transcript.
3. Acceptance and Enrollment (or your written intent to enroll by September 2011) at an accredited 4-year College or University.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

1. Financial Need.
2. Academic Accomplishments.
3. Citizenship, Community Service, and Extracurricular Activities.
4. Teacher and/or Counselor Recommendations.
5. Two Written Essays (up to 500 words total/2 pages maximum about "What will this Scholarship mean to me? How do I plan to use these Scholarship funds?") Please see Section IV of this application for more details.
6. Interview with our Scholarship committee of all Finalists.

The award of this Scholarship is at the sole discretion of the Thalia Murray Scholarship Fund Committee. The Committee's decision is final and is based on reviewing each application in its entirety. Our finalists will be invited to the UC High School Scholarship and Awards Ceremony on Thursday June 2, 2011 at the UC High Gymnasium. Your parents or guardians will also be invited to attend.

One-half of the Scholarship amount (\$1,000.00) will be presented to the recipient at the Scholarship and Awards Ceremony. The remaining one-half (\$1,000.00) will be presented at the successful conclusion of the recipient's first Semester or first Quarter at an accredited 4-year college, as defined by:

1. An official Transcript showing not less than 12 units of study for your initial Quarter or 14 units of study for your initial Semester of study.
2. A GPA of not less than 3.0 ("B" average) for the above units of study.
3. Full-time Enrollment for the second Semester or Quarter at the same 4-year college, as shown by an official schedule of classes that the Scholarship recipient will submit with a note to Bruce and Kevin Murray about your experiences at college during your first Semester or your first Quarter.

We wish you a great Senior year, as you prepare to graduate from UC High and to pursue your advanced education.
